## HOUSE BILL NO. 947 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 63-7-91, 63-7-93, 63-7-95 AND 63-7-99, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPLAY OF REFLECTORIZED STRIPS IN LIEU OF A TRIANGULAR EMBLEM TO IDENTIFY 3 SLOW-MOVING VEHICLES ON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND CITY STREETS; TO 5 REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY, BY RULE AND REGULATION, TO ESTABLISH SPECIFICATIONS FOR POSITIONING AND MOUNTING SUCH 6 STRIPS ON VEHICLES; TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SUCH STRIPS ON OTHER 7 VEHICLES OR STATIONARY OBJECTS ON OR ALONG ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR 8 STREET; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 63-7-91, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11
- amended as follows: 12
- 63-7-91. When any vehicle, whether pulled, towed, 13
- self-propelled or animal-drawn, which is not under ordinary 14
- 15 circumstances moved, operated or driven at a speed in excess of
- 16 twenty-five (25) miles per hour, is moved, operated or driven on
- any public highway or city street which is open for vehicular 17
- 18 travel, it shall display a triangular slow-moving-vehicle emblem
- or reflectorized strips mounted as near as practicable to the 19
- center of the mass and at an approximate height of not less than 20
- two (2) nor more than six (6) feet from level ground or pavement 21
- surface. In any event, the emblem or strips shall be mounted so 22
- 23 as to be entirely visible from the rear, day or night; and \* \* \*
- the emblem or strips and their position of mounting on the vehicle 24
- shall meet the specifications established by rules and regulations 25
- properly adopted and promulgated by the Commissioner of Public 26
- 27 Safety.
- SECTION 2. Section 63-7-93, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 28
- amended as follows: 29

- 30 63-7-93. The use of the slow-moving-vehicle emblem
- 31 <u>reflectorized strips</u> shall be restricted to the slow-moving
- 32 vehicles specified in Section 63-7-91 and the use of such emblem
- 33 or strips on any other type of vehicle or stationary object on or
- 34 along any public highway or city street is prohibited.
- 35 SECTION 3. Section 63-7-95, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 36 amended as follows:
- 37 63-7-95. The Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby
- 38 authorized, empowered and directed to adopt and promulgate rules
- 39 and regulations establishing standards and specifications for the
- 40 design, materials and mounting of a standard slow-moving-vehicle
- 41 emblem <u>and reflectorized strips</u> for the uniform identification of
- 42 slow-moving vehicles. In adopting said rules and regulations the
- 43 Commissioner of Public Safety shall consider the standard markings
- 44 used in other states, the current recommendations of the American
- 45 Society of Agricultural Engineers and the Society of Automotive
- 46 Engineers, in order that the slow-moving-vehicle emblem or strips
- 47 may be more universally recognizable and of adequate quality.
- 48 SECTION 4. Section 63-7-99, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 49 amended as follows:
- 50 63-7-99. Compliance with Section 63-7-91 shall not create a
- 51 prima facie case or presumption that such owner or operator of the
- 52 vehicle used reasonable and ordinary care in the operation of such
- 53 vehicle under the circumstances then existing by the use or
- 54 display of such slow-moving-vehicle emblem or reflectorized
- 55 strips.
- SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after July 1, 1999.
