## HOUSE BILL NO. 969

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-103-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO EXPAND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE 3 FROM 10 TO 22 MEMBERS; TO SPECIFY THAT CERTAIN OF THOSE MEMBERS SHALL BE THE VICE CHAIRMEN OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE APPROPRIATIONS 4 COMMITTEES, THE VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS 5 6 COMMITTEE, THE VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE; TO 7 INCREASE FROM ONE TO FIVE THE NUMBER OF SENATORS NOT OTHERWISE DESIGNATED THAT THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR MAY APPOINT; TO INCREASE 8 FROM TWO TO SIX THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF 9 REPRESENTATIVES NOT OTHERWISE DESIGNATED THAT THE SPEAKER MAY 10 APPOINT; TO INCREASE THE QUORUM REQUIREMENT FROM SIX TO TWELVE MEMBERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 11 12

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 27-103-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

16 27-103-101. (1) There is hereby created the Joint Legislative Budget Committee and the Legislative Budget Office 17 which shall be governed by such committee. The joint committee 18 shall be composed of the following members: Chairman and Vice 19 20 Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, the President Pro 21 Tempore of the Mississippi State Senate, the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Mississippi, the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the 22 Senate Appropriations Committee \* \* \* and five (5) members of the 23 24 Senate to be named by the Lieutenant Governor; and the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee of the House of 25 26 Representatives, the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives, the 27 28 Speaker of the House of Representatives and six (6) members of the 29 House of Representatives to be named by the Speaker of the House. 30 In the event any ex officio member of the joint committee holds two (2) positions entitling him to membership on said committee, 31

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the Lieutenant Governor or the Speaker of the House, as the case 32 33 may be, shall appoint another member of the respective house to membership on the committee. The chairmanship shall alternate for 34 35 twelve-month periods between the Speaker of the House of 36 Representatives and the Lieutenant Governor, with the Speaker of 37 the House of Representatives serving as the first chairman. \* \* \* If <u>a committee</u> member is unable to attend, another legislator may 38 39 be designated to attend by the Lieutenant Governor or the Speaker of the House, as the case may be. If the Lieutenant Governor or 40 Speaker of the House is unable to attend a meeting, he may 41 42 designate a legislator to substitute for him at that meeting. Ιf 43 the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate is unable to attend 44 a meeting, the Lieutenant Governor shall designate a member of the Senate to substitute for him at that meeting. Any proxy shall 45 46 have a vote at the meeting he was selected to attend and also shall, when attending, receive compensation and expenses in the 47 same manner and amount as regular members of the joint committee. 48 49 There shall be no business transacted, including adoption of

50 rules of procedure, without the presence of a quorum of the joint 51 committee. A quorum shall be twelve (12) members, to consist of six (6) members from the Senate and six (6) members from the House 52 53 of Representatives. No action shall be valid unless approved by the majority of those members present and voting, entered upon the 54 minutes of the joint committee and signed by the chairman and vice 55 56 chairman. All actions of the joint committee shall be approved by 57 at least <u>six (6)</u> Senate members and <u>six (6)</u> House members.

As used in Sections 27-103-101 through 27-103-139, the term "committee" shall mean the Joint Legislative Budget Committee.

60 (2) The members of the committee shall receive, in addition 61 to other compensation due them, per diem as is authorized by law for their services in carrying out the duties of the committee 62 63 and, in addition thereto, shall receive a daily expense allowance 64 equal to the maximum daily expense rate allowable to employees of 65 the federal government for travel in the high rate geographical 66 area of Jackson, Mississippi, as may be established by federal 67 regulations, including mileage as authorized by Section 25-3-41, 68 the same to be paid from the operating budget of the Legislative

H. B. No. 969 99\HR03\R1363 PAGE 2 69 Budget Office. Provided, however, in no case shall the members of 70 the committee draw per diem while the Legislature is in regular or 71 special session.

72 (3) The committee shall meet at least once each month; and 73 the chairman or director may call additional meetings at such 74 times as they deem necessary or advisable.

75 (4) The Legislative Budget Office shall, upon the request of 76 a member or member-elect of the Senate or House of 77 Representatives, make available one (1) copy of data, reports, 78 fiscal information or related information submitted to the budget 79 office by any general or special fund agency, whether submitted in 80 support of its budget request or pursuant to any requirement of 81 law or rule of the budget committee or office.

82 (5) All expenses incurred by and on behalf of the committee
83 shall be paid from funds appropriated therefor, or from a sum to
84 be provided in equal portion from the contingency funds of the
85 Senate and House of Representatives or from transfers of funds as
86 provided in Section 7-13-7.

87 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 and after July 1, 1999.

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
