HOUSE BILL NO. 969 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-103-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO EXPAND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE 3 FROM 10 TO 14 MEMBERS; TO INCREASE FROM ONE TO THREE THE NUMBER OF SENATORS NOT OTHERWISE DESIGNATED THAT THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR MAY 4 5 APPOINT; TO INCREASE FROM TWO TO FOUR THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE 6 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES NOT OTHERWISE DESIGNATED THAT THE SPEAKER 7 MAY APPOINT; TO INCREASE THE QUORUM REQUIREMENT FROM SIX TO EIGHT MEMBERS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMITTEE IS NOT REQUIRED TO MEET AT 8 LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 27-103-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

27-103-101. (1) There is * * * created the Joint 13 Legislative Budget Committee and the Legislative Budget Office 14 15 which shall be governed by such committee. The joint committee 16 shall be composed of the following members: The Chairman of the 17 Senate Finance Committee, the President Pro Tempore of the 18 Mississippi State Senate, the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Mississippi, the Chairman of the Senate Appropriations 19 Committee * * * and three (3) members of the Senate to be named by 20 the Lieutenant Governor; the Chairman of the Ways and Means 21 22 Committee of the House of Representatives, the Chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives, the 23 24 Speaker of the House of Representatives and four (4) members of the House of Representatives to be named by the Speaker of the 25 House. In the event any ex officio member of the joint committee 26 27 holds two (2) positions entitling him to membership on the 28 committee, the Lieutenant Governor or the Speaker of the House, as 29 the case may be, shall appoint another member of the respective

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house to membership on the committee. The chairmanship shall 30 31 alternate for twelve-month periods between the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Lieutenant Governor, with the 32 Speaker of the House of Representatives serving as the first 33 34 chairman. In the absence of the Chairman of the Senate Finance 35 Committee, Senate Appropriations Committee, House Appropriations Committee and Ways and Means Committee, the vice chairman of any 36 37 such committee shall be entitled to attend; if the vice chairman is unable to attend or if an appointed member is unable to attend, 38 another legislator may be designated to attend by the Lieutenant 39 Governor or the Speaker of the House, as the case may be. If the 40 41 Lieutenant Governor or Speaker of the House is unable to attend a 42 meeting, he may designate a legislator to substitute for him at that meeting. If the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate is 43 44 unable to attend a meeting, the Lieutenant Governor shall designate a member of the Senate to substitute for him at that 45 meeting. Any proxy shall have a vote at the meeting he was 46 selected to attend and also shall, when attending, receive 47 48 compensation and expenses in the same manner and amount as regular 49 members of the joint committee.

50 There shall be no business transacted, including adoption of 51 rules of procedure, without the presence of a quorum of the joint committee. A quorum shall be eight (8) members, to consist of 52 four (4) members from the Senate and four (4) members from the 53 House of Representatives. No action shall be valid unless 54 approved by the majority of those members present and voting, 55 56 entered upon the minutes of the joint committee and signed by the 57 chairman and vice chairman. All actions of the joint committee 58 shall be approved by at least <u>four (4)</u> Senate members and <u>four (4)</u> 59 House members.

As used in Sections 27-103-101 through 27-103-139, the term "committee" shall mean the Joint Legislative Budget Committee. (2) The members of the committee shall receive, in addition to other compensation due them, per diem as is authorized by law for their services in carrying out the duties of the committee and, in addition thereto, shall receive a daily expense allowance equal to the maximum daily expense rate allowable to employees of

No. 969 99\HR03\R1363SG PAGE 2 67 the federal government for travel in the high rate geographical 68 area of Jackson, Mississippi, as may be established by federal 69 regulations, including mileage as authorized by Section 25-3-41, 70 the same to be paid from the operating budget of the Legislative 71 Budget Office. * * * However, in no case shall the members of the 72 committee draw per diem while the Legislature is in regular or 73 special session.

74 (3) The committee <u>may</u> meet at least once each month; and the 75 chairman or director may call additional meetings at such times as 76 they deem necessary or advisable.

(4) The Legislative Budget Office shall, upon the request of
a member or member-elect of the Senate or House of
Representatives, make available one (1) copy of data, reports,
fiscal information or related information submitted to the budget
office by any general or special fund agency, whether submitted in
support of its budget request or pursuant to any requirement of
law or rule of the budget committee or office.

84 (5) All expenses incurred by and on behalf of the committee
85 shall be paid from funds appropriated therefor, or from a sum to
86 be provided in equal portion from the contingency funds of the
87 Senate and House of Representatives or from transfers of funds as
88 provided in Section 7-13-7.

89 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after January 1, 2000.

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
