(h) "Low-income child" means a child whose family 28 29 income does not exceed two hundred percent (200%) of the poverty level for a family of the size involved. 30 "Plan" means the State Child Health Plan. 31 (i) "Program" means the Children's Health Care Program 32 (j) established by Sections 41-86-5 through 41-86-17. 33 34 (k) "Recipient" means a person who is eligible for 35 assistance under the program. 36 (1) "State Child Health Plan" means the permanent plan 37 that sets forth the manner and means by which the State of Mississippi will provide health care assistance to eligible 38 uninsured, low-income children consistent with the provisions of 39 Title XXI of the federal Social Security Act, as amended. 40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 42 and after July 1, 1999.
