HOUSE BILL NO. 1038

1 AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-143-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
2 1972, TO PROVIDE GRADUATE DEGREE TEACHER EDUCATION INCENTIVE LOANS
3 TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS AGREEING TO TEACH IN PUBLIC SCHOOL
4 DISTRICTS OR STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING; TO AUTHORIZE
5 STIPENDS FOR SUCH STUDENTS IN GRADUATE TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS;
6 TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONVERSION OF SUCH LOANS INTO INTEREST-FREE
7 SCHOLARSHIPS BY PERFORMING TEACHING SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED
8 PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
11 37-143-12, Mississippi Code of 1972:

12 37-143-12. There is created a program for graduate study in
13 teacher education. Scholarships are established and shall be
14 allocated to graduate degree students who: (a) have been employed
15 as licensed teachers in a public school district in Mississippi
16 for not less than three (3) school years, or have been employed as
17 a university instructor in a Mississippi institution of higher
18 learning for not less than three (3) academic years; (b) are
19 approved by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
20 Learning; and (c) contract with the board of trustees and its
21 successors in office, obligating themselves to pursue to
22 completion the course of study agreed upon, and immediately
23 following the completion of such work, to spend a period of time,
24 equal to the period of study provided under the scholarship, in
25 teaching in any public school district or institution of higher
26 learning in Mississippi, as approved by the board of trustees.
27 Such period of service, after completion of study under a
28 scholarship, shall in no event be less than one (1) year.

29 In addition to a scholarship, any such student may be

30 allocated a loan not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)
31 per month for each month of full-time study in a graduate teacher
32 education program. The repayment of the principal and interest of
33 such loans shall be eligible for deferment during attendance as a
34 full-time student in an approved program for graduate study in an
35 accredited school of teacher education. For any student who
36 receives this loan, the student's contract with the board of
37 trustees shall obligate the student, immediately following
38 completion of the course of study, to repay the loan by teaching
39 for not less than two (2) years at any public school district or
40 institution of higher learning in Mississippi, as approved by the
41 board of trustees. Such teaching service shall convert the loan
42 to an interest-free scholarship, and discharge the same, on the
43 basis of two (2) years of service for one (1) year's loan amount,
44 or the appropriate proportion of the total outstanding balance of
45 principal and interest, all as established by rule and regulation
46 of the board of trustees. Any student who fails to complete all
47 of the teaching service obligation shall be liable to the board of
48 trustees for the remaining balance of the principal and interest
49 that remains undischarged.

50 The board of trustees shall establish such rules and
51 regulations as it deems necessary and proper to carry out the
52 purposes and intent of this section.

53 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
54 and after July 1, 1999.
