HOUSE BILL NO. 1062

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE RETAILERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, BEER AND 2 LIGHT WINES TO DISPLAY SIGNS ON THE PREMISES WHERE THE ALCOHOLIC 3 BEVERAGES ARE SOLD THAT INFORM THE PUBLIC THAT DRINKING ALCOHOLIC 4 BEVERAGES DURING PREGNANCY CAN CAUSE BIRTH DEFECTS; TO PROVIDE A 5 PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO DISPLAY THOSE SIGNS; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Each holder of a package retailer's permit, 8 9 on-premises retailer's permit or native wine retailer's permit 10 shall display on the premises where the permittee sells alcoholic 11 beverages at least one (1) sign that reads substantially as 12 "WARNING! DRINKING WINE, BEER OR OTHER ALCOHOLIC follows: BEVERAGES DURING PREGNANCY CAN CAUSE BIRTH DEFECTS. " The sign or 13 signs shall be at least eighteen (18) inches long and eighteen 14 (18) inches high with lettering not less than one (1) inch in 15 height, and one (1) sign must be easily visible from the location 16 in the premises where the consumer purchases or otherwise receives 17 18 the alcoholic beverages.

Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of this section shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) if convicted and upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor. However, if a person remedies the noncompliance by the time of the person's scheduled court appearance, all charges shall be dismissed against the person.

25 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Each holder of a permit or privilege license to 26 engage in the business of a retailer of beer or light wines shall 27 display on the premises where the permittee or licensee sells beer 28 or light wines at least one (1) sign that reads substantially as

The sign or signs shall be at least eighteen (18) inches long and eighteen (18) inches high with lettering not less than one (1) inch in height, and one (1) sign must be easily visible from the location in the premises where the consumer purchases or otherwise receives the beer or light wines.

Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of this section shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) if convicted and upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor. However, if a person remedies the noncompliance by the time of the person's scheduled court appearance, all charges shall be dismissed against the person.

42 SECTION 3. Section 1 shall be codified as a new section in 43 Chapter 1 of Title 67, Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 2 shall 44 be codified as a new section in Chapter 3 of Title 67, Mississippi 45 Code of 1972.

46 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 47 and after July 1, 1999.
