HOUSE BILL NO. 1114

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 27-19-155 AND 47-5-545, MISSISSIPPI
2	CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE STATE LICENSE TAGS TO BE MANUFACTURED BY
3	THE MISSISSIPPI PRISON INDUSTRIES CORPORATION; TO PROVIDE THAT
4	SECTION 27-19-157, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH REQUIRES

- LICENSE TAGS TO BE PURCHASED FROM THE PENITENTIARY, IF THE 5
- PRISONERS ARE REQUIRED TO MANUFACTURE THE LICENSE TAGS, WILL BE REPEALED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8
- 9 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-155, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 27-19-155. The license or number tag herein provided for 11
- shall be purchased by the License Tag Commission <u>from the</u> 12
- Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation as created under 13
- Sections 47-5-531 through 47-5-575. The License Tag Commission 14
- 15 shall be composed of the Governor, Commissioner of Revenue,
- Attorney General, and the State Treasurer * * *. * * 16
- License Tag Commission is hereby authorized and empowered to 17
- renegotiate any contract entered into with the Mississippi Prison 18
- <u>Industries Corporation</u> for the purchase of license tags in order 19
- 20 to obtain any other or additional tags necessitated by the passage
- of this article. 21
- 22 All license tags and numbered plates purchased under the
- provisions of this article, shall be paid for pursuant to an 23
- 24 appropriation to be made for such purposes. All monies received
- by the State Tax Commission as registration or tag fees, either 25
- from the tax collectors, or from licenses issued by the State Tax 26
- 27 Commission, shall be paid into the State Treasury on the same day
- in which such funds are collected by the State Tax Commission. 28

- SECTION 2. Section 47-5-545, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 30 amended as follows:
- 31 47-5-545. (1) Except as otherwise specifically provided by
- 32 law, after the commissioning and implementation of a marketing
- 33 feasibility study for any proposed new prison industry, the
- 34 corporation may establish such prison industry. Before any new
- 35 industry is established, the corporation shall hold a hearing to
- 36 determine the impact such industry may have on the private sector
- 37 market. The corporation shall provide adequate and advance notice
- 38 regarding the nature, time, date and place of such hearing. After
- 39 the hearing which is required under this section, the corporation
- 40 may commence negotiations with the State Department of
- 41 Corrections, with the Secretary of State, or his designee, serving
- 42 as a mediator, regarding the leasing of land and other chattels
- 43 for the purpose of establishing any new industry.
- 44 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this
- 45 section, the corporation shall contract with the License Tag
- 46 <u>Commission as created in Section 27-19-155, for the manufacture of</u>
- 47 <u>state license tags and numbered plates. All specifications for</u>
- 48 the state license tags shall be prescribed by the License Tag
- 49 <u>Commission</u>.
- SECTION 3. Section 27-19-157, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 51 which provides that state license tags are to be purchased from
- 52 the Penitentiary, if prisoners are required to manufacture the
- 53 license tags, is repealed.
- 54 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 55 and after July 1, 1999.
