HOUSE BILL NO. 1146

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 87-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY EVIDENCE OF A PRINCIPAL'S INTENT TO GIVE AN
- 3 ATTORNEY-IN-FACT OR AGENT FULL POWER TO GIVE GIFTS IN ACCORDANCE
- 4 WITH THE PRINCIPAL'S PERSONAL HISTORY OF MAKING OR JOINING IN THE
- 5 MAKING OF LIFETIME GIFTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 87-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 87-3-7. (1) A letter of attorney to transact any business
- 10 need only express plainly the authority conferred.
- 11 (2) If any power of attorney or other writing (i) authorizes
- 12 <u>an attorney-in-fact or other agent to do, execute, or perform any</u>
- 13 act that the principal might or could do or (ii) evidences the
- 14 principal's intent to give the attorney-in-fact or agent full
- 15 power to handle the principal's affairs or deal with the
- 16 principal's property, the attorney-in-fact or agent shall have the
- 17 power and authority to make gifts in any amount of any of the
- 18 principal's property to any individuals or to any organizations
- 19 <u>described in Sections 170(c) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue</u>
- 20 Code or corresponding future provisions of the federal tax law, or
- 21 both, in accordance with the principal's personal history of
- 22 <u>making or joining in the making of lifetime gifts.</u>
- 23 (3) Subsection (2) of this section is declaratory of past
- 24 and present law in the State of Mississippi, and shall be applied
- 25 to all powers of attorney, whether executed before, on or after
- 26 <u>the effective date of this act.</u>
- 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after its passage.
