- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Personnel Board shall adjust the
- 6 Colonial Guy Groff State Variable Compensation Plan in a manner
- 7 which will effectuate an annual increase in the compensation of
- 8 each State Highway Safety Patrol officer in full-time employment
- 9 with the Department of Public Safety beginning with fiscal year
- 10 1999-2000 by an amount equal to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).
- 11 (2) If the increases in compensation provided for in this
- 12 section would cause any employee's compensation to be in excess of
- 13 the compensation of the Commissioner of Public Safety, then that
- 14 employee's compensation shall be increased only to the extent that
- 15 the employee's salary will be equal in amount to the compensation
- 16 of the Commissioner of Public Safety.
- 17 (3) The Legislature shall appropriate the funds necessary to
- 18 provide for the increases in compensation provided for in this
