- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Department of Education is hereby
- 7 directed to create a pilot project in two (2) school districts in
- 8 each of the five (5) congressional districts which will develop
- 9 innovative methods to keep children in school. The Legislature
- 10 shall appropriate sufficient funds from tobacco litigation funds
- 11 to cover the costs of the pilot project.
- 12 (2) The State Department of Education shall promulgate any
- 13 rules and regulations necessary to carry out such pilot project.
- 14 The department shall report to the Legislature in January 2000, on
- 15 the effectiveness of the pilot project and shall make
- 16 recommendations to the Legislature regarding statewide
- 17 implementation of such project.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after its passage.
