HOUSE BILL NO. 1218 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS TO GRANT 1 2 <u>RIGHTS-OF-WAY TO COUNTIES AND CITIES ACROSS SIXTEENTH SECTION AND</u> <u>LIEU LANDS IN EXCHANGE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC ROADS ON</u> 3 4 SUCH LANDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 29-3-91, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 29-3-91. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) 8 of this section, whenever the United States or any agency thereof, 9 10 or the state or any agency or subdivision thereof, or any private organization, corporation, association, or person acquires, by 11 12 condemnation or otherwise, any easement or right-of-way across any 13 sixteenth section land or lieu land, then adequate compensation therefor shall be paid by the party acquiring the same to the 14 15 board of education concerned; and the sum or sums so received shall be placed in the principal fund or funds of the school 16 17 district or districts concerned. (2) If the local board of education, by resolution duly 18 19 adopted and spread upon its minutes, determines that a new road is 20 necessary to provide access to and on sixteenth section land or lieu land, that the new road will enhance the value of the 21 sixteenth section land or lieu land, and requests that a county or 22 23 city construct and maintain the road, then, upon agreement by the county or city to bear all costs of construction and maintenance, 24 25 the local board of education may provide a right-of-way for the 26 new road without compensation from the county or city if the 27 initial cost of constructing the new road exceeds the value of the

29 discretion in determining the location of any new road constructed

30 <u>under the authority of this subsection</u>. This subsection shall not

31 apply to state road projects or to any change or improvement to or

32 relocation of existing roads under the jurisdiction of a county or

33 <u>city.</u>

34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after its passage.
