17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI
18	$\underline{\mathtt{SECTION}\ 1.}$ (1) A special fund, to be designated as the
19	"1999 Mississippi Employment Security Commission Building Fund,"
20	is created within the State Treasury. The fund shall be
21	maintained by the State Treasurer separate and apart from the
22	General Fund of the state, and investment earnings on amounts in
23	the fund shall be deposited into such fund. The State Fiscal
24	Officer shall transfer a sum not to exceed Nine Million Dollars
25	(\$9,000,000.00) to this special fund from the following funds:

- 34 Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal
- 35 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest
- 36 earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of

- 38 (2) Monies deposited into the fund shall be disbursed in the
- 39 discretion of the Department of Finance and Administration to pay
