HOUSE BILL NO. 1236 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY 1 2 ENTITLED THE "1999 MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION 3 (MESC) BUILDING FUND"; TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$9,000,000.00 FROM MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT SECURITY FUNDS TO 4 5 THE SPECIAL FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES PLACED IN THE SPECIAL 6 FUND WILL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTING A 7 NEW OFFICE FACILITY FOR THE MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MESC BUILDING FUND MAY ALSO BE 8 9 USED TO PURCHASE LAND FOR THE NEW OFFICE FACILITY IN THE EVENT THAT APPROPRIATE STATE-OWNED LAND CANNOT BE OBTAINED; TO PROVIDE 10 11 THAT THE MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION MAY OBTAIN THE LAND UPON WHICH THE NEW FACILITY IS BUILT BY ANY MANNER ALLOWED 12 UNDER THE LAW; TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI MAY 13 14 DONATE, TRANSFER OR CONVEY BY ANY OTHER MEANS, LAND TO THE MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION FOR RELOCATION 15 16 PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 18 SECTION 1. (1) A special fund, to be designated as the "1999 Mississippi Employment Security Commission Building Fund," 19 is created within the State Treasury. The fund shall be 20 maintained by the State Treasurer separate and apart from the 21 2.2 General Fund of the state, and investment earnings on amounts in 23 the fund shall be deposited into such fund. The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer a sum not to exceed Nine Million Dollars 24 25 (\$9,000,000.00) to this special fund from the following funds: 26 (a) The Mississippi Employment Security Administration Fund, Number 3671; 27 28 (b) The Mississippi Employment Security Special Administration Fund, Number 3672; and 29 30 (c) The Mississippi Employment Security Buildings and 31 Land Fund, Number 3673. 32 The transfer shall be made on the dates and in the amounts as determined by the Mississippi Employment Security Commission. 33

H. B. No. 1236 99\HR03\R1759 PAGE 1 34 Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal 35 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest 36 earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of 37 the fund.

38 (2) Monies deposited into the fund shall be disbursed in the
39 discretion of the Department of Finance and Administration to pay
40 the costs of the following:

(a) Planning and constructing a new office facility for
the Mississippi Security Employment Commission to be located
within the city limits of Jackson, Mississippi.

44 (b) Providing for moving costs, reestablishment of
45 computer networks, communication and other necessary expenses
46 associated with the relocation of the Mississippi Employment
47 Security Commission.

48 (c) Purchasing privately owned land in the event that49 appropriate state-owned land cannot be obtained.

50 (3) Money deposited into the special fund shall not exceed 51 the total amount of Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000.00).

Amounts deposited in the special fund shall be disbursed 52 (4) 53 to pay the costs of the projects described in this section. The expenditure of monies deposited into the special fund shall be 54 55 under the direction of the Department of Finance and Administration, and such funds shall be paid by the State 56 57 Treasurer upon warrants issued upon requisitions signed by the 58 State Fiscal Officer.

59 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Mississippi Employment Security 60 Commission may obtain the land upon which the new office facility 61 will be constructed by any means allowed under the law, including 62 but not limited to, the following means:

(a) Purchasing privately owned land;

(b) Receiving, by grant or other type of conveyance,
state-owned land which is available and suitable for construction
and which adequately meets the needs of the Mississippi Employment
Security Commission;

(d) Receiving land by gift or donation;
(e) Obtaining land through a lease-purchase
arrangement; or
(f) Receiving land by any other means legally
applicable.
(2) The State of Mississippi may donate, transfer, exchange
or convey by any other means, land to the Mississippi Employment

Security Commission for relocation purposes.

80 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 1999.
