AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO 1 2 CONDUCT A STUDY ON SUSPENSIONS AND EXPULSIONS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A REPORT OF ITS 3 FINDINGS TO THE HOUSE AND SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEES; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Department of Education shall conduct a 8 study on suspensions and expulsions in the public schools. Before January 1, 2000, the department shall submit a written report to 9 the Education Committees of the House of Representatives and the 10 Senate detailing its findings. The report shall include, but not 11 be limited to, the following information: 12 13 (a) The total number of students suspended in all 14 public schools in the state during the 1998-1999 school year; 15 The total number of students suspended in each (b) school district and the number suspended in each grade in that 16 district during the 1998-1999 school year; 17 (c) The total number of students expelled from all 18 public schools in the state during the 1998-1999 school year; 19 (d) The total number of students expelled in each 20 21 school district and the number expelled in each grade in that district during the 1998-1999 school year; 22 23 (e) An explanation of the most common reasons that students were suspended during the 1998-1999 school year; 24 (f) An explanation of the most common reasons that 25 students were expelled during the 1998-1999 school year; and 26 (g) Recommendations for reducing the number of 27

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after its passage.
