COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1315

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-15-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS OPERATING 3 CRANES OR SIMILAR EQUIPMENT WITHIN TEN FEET OF HIGH VOLTAGE
- OVERHEAD LINES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 45-15-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 45-15-11. No person shall <u>use or</u> operate any <u>tools</u>,
- 9 equipment, crane, derrick, power shovel, drilling rig, pile
- 10 driver, hoisting equipment, or similar apparatus, or any part
- thereof, * * * within ten (10) feet of any high voltage overhead 11
- 12 line, unless:
- There is posted and maintained a warning sign, 13
- as * * * defined in Section 45-15-1, clearly legible and placed as 14
- follows: 15
- 16 Within the equipment readily visible to the
- 17 operator of such equipment when at the controls of such equipment;
- 18 and
- 19 (ii) On the outside of the equipment in such
- 20 number and location as to be readily visible to mechanics or other
- persons engaged in the work operations; 21
- 22 (b) There is installed an insulated cage-type guard or
- 23 protective device about the boom or arm of all equipment, except
- backhoes or dippers and, where the equipment includes a lifting 24
- 25 hook device, all lifting lines are equipped with insulator links
- on the lift hook connection; and 26
- 27 (c) A person is designated to observe clearance of the

- 28 equipment from any nearby high voltage overhead lines and to give
- 29 timely warning for all operations where it is difficult, by visual
- 30 $means_{\perp}$ for the operator to determine and to maintain the required
- 31 clearance.
- 32 (d) Before operating the equipment, the person whose
- 33 operations could come within ten (10) feet of any high voltage
- 34 <u>overhead line shall ascertain whether any part of any high voltage</u>
- 35 overhead line is located so that the operation of the equipment
- 36 might bring any person, tools, equipment, crane, derrick, power
- 37 <u>shovel, drilling rig, pile driver, hoisting equipment or similar</u>
- 38 apparatus, or any part thereof, into physical or electrical
- 39 <u>contact with the high voltage overhead line, and this person shall</u>
- 40 <u>advise employees of the location of the high voltage overhead</u>
- 41 lines, the hazards involved and the protective measures to be
- 42 <u>taken.</u>
- 43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 1999.
