HOUSE BILL NO. 1317

- AN ACT TO AMEND HOUSE BILL NO. 519, 1999 REGULAR SESSION, TO RENAME THE ACT AS THE "MISSISSIPPI TOBACCO TRUST FUND ACT OF 3 1999"; TO DELETE REFERENCE TO CREATION OF THE "HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND, " TO CREATE "TOBACCO TRUST FUND" AND TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES 5 FROM SETTLEMENT OF THE LAWSUIT AGAINST TOBACCO COMPANIES BY THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE TREASURY INTO THE TOBACCO TRUST FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT INTEREST AND INCOME EARNED 6 7 ON THE PRINCIPAL OF THE TRUST SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL 8 9 FUND OF THE STATE TREASURY AND MAY BE EXPENDED, UPON LEGISLATIVE 10 APPROPRIATION, IN SUCH MANNER AND FOR SUCH PURPOSES AS THE
- 11 LEGISLATURE DEEMS APPROPRIATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. House Bill No. 519, 1999 Regular Session, is 13

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 15
- 16 "Mississippi <u>Tobacco</u> Trust Fund Act of 1999."

- Section 2. When used in this act, the following definitions 18
- 19 shall apply, unless the context requires otherwise:
- 20 (a) "Act" means the Mississippi <u>Tobacco</u> Trust Fund Act
- of 1999. 21
- (b) "Tobacco Trust Fund" means the trust fund 22
- established by Section 3 of this act for the deposit of the monies 23
- 24 received by the State of Mississippi as a result of the tobacco
- settlement * * *. 25
- 26 (c) "Tobacco settlement" means the settlement of the
- 2.7 case of Mike Moore, Attorney General ex rel. State of Mississippi
- v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery Court of Jackson 28
- County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) and the settlement of any 29
- 30 case brought against tobacco companies by another state.

- 31 Section $\underline{3}$. * * * There is established in the State Treasury
- 32 the <u>Tobacco</u> Trust Fund, into which shall be deposited all monies
- 33 that are received by the State of Mississippi as a result of the
- 34 tobacco settlement for which the use or purpose for expenditure is
- 35 not restricted by the terms of the settlement. The principal of
- 36 the Tobacco Trust Fund shall remain inviolate and shall never be
- 37 <u>expended</u>. All interest <u>and income earned on the principal shall</u>
- 38 be deposited by the State Treasurer in the State General Fund and
- 39 may be expended, upon legislative appropriation in such manner and
- 40 for such purposes as the legislature deems appropriate.

- Section $\underline{4}$. (1) The State Treasurer shall invest the monies
- 43 of the <u>Tobacco</u> Trust Fund in any of the investments authorized for
- 44 the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program under
- 45 Section 37-155-9, and those investments shall be subject to the
- 46 limitations prescribed by Section 37-155-9.
- 47 (2) All interest derived from investments and any gains from
- 48 the sale or exchange of investments shall be credited to the <u>State</u>
- 49 <u>General</u> Fund.

- Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 52 and after its passage.
