Section 63-5-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 7 63-5-13. The total outside width of any vehicle, exclusive 8 of required safety devices, or the load thereon shall not exceed 9 10 eight and one-half (8-1/2) feet; however, vehicles hauling 11 unprocessed forest products on roads, streets or highways other than interstate highways shall be allowed a total outside width of 12 13 <u>ten (10) feet.</u> The total outside width of a farm tractor shall not exceed 14 15 ten (10) feet, except that farm tractors shall not be operated upon the interstate highways without a special permit from the 16 17 State Highway Commission. 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
