HOUSE BILL NO. 1382

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI EMPLOYMENT
2 SECURITY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING INTENSIVE JOB
3 DEVELOPMENT AND JOB REFERRAL ASSISTANCE TO TANF RECIPIENTS FOR THE
4 FISCAL YEAR 2000.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Employment
9 Security Commission for the purpose of providing intensive job
10 development and job referral assistance to recipients of Temporary
11 Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) benefits, as provided in House
12 Bill No. _____, 1999 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning
13 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$1,677,885.00.

14 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
15 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
16 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
17 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
18 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
19 officers in the manner provided by law.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after July 1, 1999.
