HOUSE BILL NO. 1386

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE ONE MILLION
2 DOLLARS ANNUALLY FOR A RESEARCH CENTER FOR ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND
3 OTHER DEMENTIA-RELATED DISEASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The Legislature shall appropriate One Million
6 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) annually for the establishment and
7 operation of a research center for research concerning Alzheimer's
8 disease and other dementia-related diseases.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
10 and after July 1, 1999.
