1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-37-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO CONTRACT WITH THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAZOO COUNTY TO HOUSE TWO HUNDRED FIFTY OFFENDERS IN A RESTITUTION CENTER; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO INSTITUTE AND ADMINISTER SERVICES AT THE RESTITUTION CENTER; TO AMEND SECTION 99-37-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
10	SECTION 1. Section 99-37-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
11	amended as follows:
12	99-37-19. $(1)$ The boards of supervisors of the several
13	counties and the governing authorities of municipalities are
14	hereby authorized to cooperate with the Department of Corrections
15	in the establishment of restitution centers. Such centers may
16	house both probationers referred by the circuit courts as well as
17	inmates transferred from other facilities of the Department of
18	Corrections as provided in Section 47-5-110. Except as provided
19	in subsection (3) of this section, such centers shall be operated
20	by the Department of Corrections. County or municipal property
21	may be utilized with the approval of the board of supervisors or
22	municipal governing authority for the construction, renovation and
23	maintenance of facilities owned by the state or a local political
24	subdivision. Such facility may be leased to the Department of
25	Corrections for a period of time for use as a restitution center.
26	(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, it
27	is the intent of this section that county and local governments
28	contribute only to the establishment, renovation and maintenance

of the physical plant of a restitution center and that the

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- 30 Department of Corrections support the operation of, and have sole
- 31 jurisdiction over and responsibility for offenders in, such
- 32 restitution program.
- 33 (<u>3</u>) The Department of Corrections is authorized to contract
- 34 with the Board of Supervisors of Yazoo County to house two hundred
- 35 fifty (250) offenders in a restitution center owned or leased by
- 36 <u>the county. The board of supervisors shall be responsible for the</u>
- 37 housing, care and control of the offenders; however, the
- 38 <u>Department of Corrections and the Department of Human Services</u>
- 39 <u>shall institute and administer services at the restitution center</u>
- 40 as provided in Section 99-37-21.
- 41 SECTION 2. Section 99-37-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 42 amended as follows:
- 43 99-37-21. (1) The Department of <u>Human Services</u> and the
- 44 Department of Corrections are hereby authorized to cooperate in
- 45 the institution and administration of services at restitution
- 46 centers as authorized by Section 99-37-19 and at other facilities
- 47 which provide opportunities for restitution for criminal acts.
- 48 (2) The Department of <u>Human Services</u> and the Department of
- 49 Corrections are authorized and directed, jointly or separately:
- 50 (a) To seek funding from federal or other sources to
- 51 provide the maximum supportive services for offenders and the
- 52 families of offenders who are participating in restitution
- 53 programs;
- 54 (b) To develop additional programs whereby offenders
- 55 may be afforded opportunities to contribute to society and the
- 56 support of their families through restitution programs; and
- 57 (c) To develop pilot programs of counseling, training
- 58 and supervision for parolees whereby restitution may be
- 59 accomplished; such programs may be residential or nonresidential
- 60 as appropriate.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 1999.
