## HOUSE BILL NO. 1441

1	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE APPLICABLE TO
2	PERSONS AGED 12 AND UNDER FOR FAILURE TO WEAR A BICYCLE HELMET ANI
3	PROVIDE A PENALTY THEREFOR; TO REQUIRE THAT NONMOTOR CYCLES SOLD
4	FOR USE BY PERSONS AGED 12 AND UNDER TO BE SOLD WITH HELMETS; AND
5	FOR RELATED DIRPOSES

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) No person aged twelve (12) years and under
- 8 shall operate or be a passenger on a bicycle on any public road,
- 9 street or highway in this state without wearing a bicycle helmet.
- 10 For the purpose of this section the term "bicycle helmet" means a
- 11 piece of protective headgear which meets or exceeds the impact
- 12 standards for bicycle helmets set by the American National
- 13 Standards Institute (ANSI) or the Snell Memorial Foundation. Any
- 14 person who violates this subsection shall be guilty of a
- 15 misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined Twenty-five Dollars
- 16 (\$25.00) for each violation.
- 17 (2) All nonmotorized cycles sold in the state for use by
- 18 persons aged twelve (12) and under shall be sold with a bicycle
- 19 helmet. Any person who violates this subsection shall be guilty
- 20 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than
- 21 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 1999.
