In addition to all other sums previously 8 appropriated, the following sum or so much of it as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and 10 History for the period beginning upon the passage of this act and 11 ending June 30, 2000..... \$900,000.00. 12 13 SECTION 2. This additional appropriation is made for the 14 purpose of providing funds to implement emergency measures to secure and protect the historic Shaifer House on the Port Gibson 15 Battlefield. In addition, these funds will be used to 16 substantially rehabilitate and restore the Shaifer House. The 17 preservation and interpretation of the Shaifer House on the Port 18 Gibson Battlefield will represent the state's first step in the 19 development of the Vicksburg Campaign Trail, which has been 20 21 identified by the National Trust for Historic Preservation as one of America's Eleven Most Endangered Historic Places. The 2.2 preservation and development of the state's Civil War battlefields 23 will help promote heritage tourism in Mississippi and thereby 24 25 contribute to the state's economic development. SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 26

by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund

28 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State 29 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his 30 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or 31 officers in the manner provided by law.

32 SECTION 4. The Department of Archives and History, in its 33 discretion, may transfer all or part of the funds appropriated by 34 this act to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau 35 of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management for the 36 completion of this project.

37 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from38 and after its passage.
