HOUSE BILL NO. 1503

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
2 STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO ENHANCE THE JACKSON STATE
3 UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF BUSINESS DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN BUSINESS
4 ADMINISTRATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State
9 Institutions of Higher Learning to enhance the Jackson State
10 University School of Business doctoral program in business
11 administration for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and
12 ending June 30, 2000..... \$1,053,975.00.

13 SECTION 2. The monies appropriated by this act are for the
14 purpose of enhancing the doctoral program in business
15 administration at the Jackson State University School of Business
16 to make it comparable to other doctoral programs in business
17 across the country with similar demographics. The monies shall be
18 used to hire one (1) additional faculty member, expand the
19 computer laboratory, purchase software licenses and database
20 systems, hire necessary consultants, and for faculty and student
21 development activities.

22 SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
23 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
24 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
25 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
26 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
27 officers in the manner provided by law.

28 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
29 and after July 1, 1999.
