HOUSE BILL NO. 1553 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PONTOTOC, MISSISSIPPI, TO ACQUIRE AND ASSUME THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PRIMROSE 2 WATER ASSOCIATION AND TO ASSUME ALL THE LIABILITIES, OBLIGATIONS, ASSETS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SUCH ASSOCIATION; TO 4 5 AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PONTOTOC TO OPERATE ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM FOR A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN FIVE MILES FROM THE CORPORATE 6 LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PONTOTOC IN ORDER TO OPERATE THE WATER 7 8 SYSTEM WITHIN THE AREA PRESENTLY SERVED BY THE PRIMROSE WATER 9 SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE 10 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of the City of Pontotoc, Mississippi, in their discretion, may acquire and 13 assume the operation and maintenance of the water distribution 14 systems owned by Primrose Water Association; and, in connection 15 16 therewith, the governing authorities of the City of Pontotoc may 17 assume all liabilities, obligations, assets, duties and responsibilities of the association. The city shall have such 18 19 powers and authority concerning the association and its facilities 2.0 as is granted by law to municipalities concerning water systems. (2) Any indebtedness incurred by the City of Pontotoc as a 21 result of the exercise of the authority granted under subsection 22 (1) of this section shall not constitute a debt within the meaning 23 24 of any statutory limitation as to the amount of debt which may be incurred by the municipality. 25 26 SECTION 2. (1) (a) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the 2.7

- 31 of more than five (5) miles from the corporate limits of the City
- 32 of Pontotoc in order to operate the water system within the area
- 33 served by Primrose Water Association on the effective date of
- 34 House Bill No. , 1999 Regular Session. The rate charged to
- 35 consumers of water service furnished by the water system who
- 36 reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Pontotoc shall
- 37 be no greater than twice the rate charged to consumers who reside
- 38 within the corporate limits of the city, until the provisions of
- 39 paragraph (b) are applicable.
- 40 (b) Upon the completion of any construction, expansion
- 41 or improvement of the water system and the retirement of any
- 42 indebtedness incurred in connection therewith, the consumers of
- 43 water service furnished by the water distribution system who
- 44 reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Pontotoc shall
- 45 be charged the same rate as that charged to consumers who reside
- 46 within the corporate limits of the city.
- 47 (2) The authority conferred by this section shall not be
- 48 construed as an exemption to Chapter 3, Title 77, Mississippi Code
- 49 of 1972, concerning the requirements of obtaining a Certificate of
- 50 Public Convenience and Necessity, the jurisdiction of the Public
- 51 Service Commission to regulate rates or any other provision of law
- 52 related to the regulation of public utilities.
- 53 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after its passage.
