1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUCTIONEERS COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Auctioneers Commission
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission, for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.
10	\$ 96,895.00.
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
12	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 1
15	Part Time 0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
17	Part Time 0
18	From the funds provided herein, funds may be expended for the
19	following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by
20	the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such
21	expenditures:
22	(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
23	shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
24	appropriated herein.
25	(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
26	Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all

- 27 full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
- 28 current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
- 29 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
- 30 adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
- 31 Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- 32 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
- 33 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
- 34 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any
- 35 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a
- 36 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the
- 37 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently
- 38 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above
- 39 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase
- 40 effective the date of the rating.
- It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
- 42 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal
- 43 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for
- 44 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the
- 45 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 49 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 50 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 51 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- Of the above funds, none may be expended by this act to
- 53 provide for any regulatory authority over livestock auctioneers
- 54 conducting sales for an individual of his own property.
- 55 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 56 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 57 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 58 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 59 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 60 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 61 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 1999.
