5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Time-Limited: Full Time. 30 Part Time. 31 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 32 33 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 34 35 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 36 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 37 SECTION 3. In the event of a natural disaster or other major 38 catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits 39 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore 40 port facilities, the Port Authority and the Department of Economic 41 42 and Community Development, with the approval of the Department of 43 Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. However, 44 45 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of such funds is shown. 46 47 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized 48 49 to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with 50 applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 51 52 federal funds. SECTION 5. The money appropriated under the provisions of 53 54 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper

person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
