AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER 1 2 3 SUPPLY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the purpose 8 9 of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 10 However, funds derived from the special tax levy authorized 11 12 under the provisions of Section 51-9-139, Mississippi Code of 13 1972, shall be expended only for principal of and interest on bonds and shoreline development. 14 SECTION 2. From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

40 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
41 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
42 appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).

50 (C) If an employee is currently at or above the end 51 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 52 53 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 54 55 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 56 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 57 58 effective the date of the rating.

59 It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds 60 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal 61 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for H. B. No. 1609 99\HR05\A490 PAGE 2 62 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the 63 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

70 SECTION 3. Of the funds authorized and approved for 71 expenditure herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that not less than twenty-five percent (25%) of all revenues obtained 72 73 from the sale of timber on the Pearl River Valley Supply District 74 property shall be used for the promotion and enhancement of 75 wildlife on the Pearl River Valley Supply District property. The promotion and enhancement of wildlife and the expenditure of these 76 77 funds shall be under the supervision of and at the discretion of 78 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks.

SECTION 4. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

SECTION 5. The money herein approved for expenditure shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

90 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 91 and after July 1, 1999.

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
