Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act
- 68 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose
- 69 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of
- 70 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission
- 71 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state
- 72 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or
- 73 federal law.
- 74 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Public Service Commission shall have the authority to escalate and
- 76 expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug
- 77 seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 78 (\$50,000.00), in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 79 Department of Finance and Administration.
- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 81 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 82 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 83 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 84 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 85 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 86 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 87 and after July 1, 1999.
