31 From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal 32 Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be 33 expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the 34 policies established by the State Personnel Board and any 35 conditions placed on such expenditures:

36 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
37 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
38 appropriated herein.

39 (b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable 40 Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all 41 full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous 42 current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One 43 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to 44 adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand 45 Dollars (\$1,000.00).

46 (C) If an employee is currently at or above the end 47 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 48 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 49 50 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 51 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 52 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 53 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 54

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

60 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

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66 SECTION 3. Funds are provided in this act for the 67 reallocation of PIN 7, a Chief Investigator to a Real Estate Chief 68 Investigator not to exceed Six Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-five 69 Dollars (\$6,575.00).

SECTION 4. Funds are provided in this act for the reallocation of PIN 11, an Investigator II to a Real Estate Investigator not to exceed Two Thousand Three Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$2,317.00).

74 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Projects Officer II, Special (PIN 5) included in the "AUTHORIZED 76 POSITIONS: Permanent: Full Time" above shall be deleted when it 77 becomes vacant.

78 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 81 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 83 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 85 and after July 1, 1999.

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
