From the funds provided herein, funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).

If an employee is currently at or above the end 86 (C) 87 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 88 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 89 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 90 effective date of the increase. 91 Employees who subsequently 92 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 93 effective the date of the rating. 94

95 It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
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96 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal 97 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for 98 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the 99 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

100 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 101 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 102 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 103 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

104 Unless expressly authorized herein by the Legislature, no 105 funds appropriated shall be expended to pay expenses incurred by 106 more than four (4) employees or other representatives of the 107 agency for attending the same conference, seminar or workshop, either in-state or out-of-state; however, such funds may be 108 109 expended for expenses incurred by more than four (4) employees or other representatives for attendance at the same conference, 110 111 seminar or workshop (a) if attendance is required in order to 112 maintain professional certification or licensure, which certification or licensure is required by the employees' job 113 114 descriptions or by law, or (b) if such expenditure has received 115 the prior written approval of the Department of Finance and 116 Administration.

117 SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 118 Department of Environmental Quality shall have authority to 119 escalate the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds 120 121 collected or available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year, not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), 122 123 to the agency for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Department 124 of Environmental Quality may expend such funds in the manner 125 authorized by law.

126 The Executive Director of the Department of Environmental 127 Quality shall submit to the Department of Finance and 128 Administration a certified statement providing a detailed 129 explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the H. B. No. 1622 99\HR05\A470

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establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing positions and the existence of any required matching funds for those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's general fund budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.

135 SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 136 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 137 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 138 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 139 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 140 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

141 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 142 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 143 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. 144 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance

Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:
