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From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

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34 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
35 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
36 appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

44 If an employee is currently at or above the end (C)salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 45 46 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 47 48 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 49 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 50 51 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 52

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are H. B. No. 1626 99\HR05\A502 PAGE 2 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of thisact and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

This act shall take effect and be in force from 75 and after July 1, 1999.

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
