HOUSE BILL NO. 1628 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 3 FISCAL YEAR 2000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History 8 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 10 June 30, 2000.....\$ 6,887,154.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the 15 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 17 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 18 Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 19 20 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of expenditure: 21 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 22 Personal Services: 23 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 5,030,865.00 24 Travel and Subsistence..... 53,520.00 25 Contractual Services..... 1,546,665.00

57 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
58 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
59 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any

60 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 61 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 62 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 63 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 64 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 65 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

77 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 78 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 79 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 80 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 81 82 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 83 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 84

SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

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SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part

93 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 94 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 95 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

96 SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein 97 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 98 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 99 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 100 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and 101 ending June 30, 2000...... \$ 259,734.00.

102 With the funds appropriated in this section, the following 103 positions are authorized:

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105 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 106 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 107 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 108 Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the 109 expenditure of State General Funds, as authorized in House Bill No. 1792, Regular Session of 1997, and House Bill No. 1765, 110 111 Regular Session of 1998, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 50,000.00. 112

113 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 114 the expenditure of State General Funds to design, construct and 115 erect a monument at Gettysburg to memorialize the Eleventh 116 Mississippi Regiment.

117 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 118 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 119 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 1999.

158	SECTION 1	1. With the funds provided herein, it is the	

159 intention of the Legislature that the Department of Archives and 160 History shall provide One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to the 161 City of Biloxi for the support of the <u>George E. Ohr Arts and</u> 162 <u>Cultural Center</u>.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 163 164 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 165 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 166 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 167 168 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 169 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 170
