HOUSE BILL NO. 1629

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ARTS COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 3 YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the 8 9 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 11 12 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts 13 Commission which is comprised of special source funds and donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission, 14 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000. 16\$ 923,042.00. 17 SECTION 3. 57 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
58 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
59 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any

60 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 61 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 62 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 63 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 64 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 65 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 87 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars 88 89 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans 90 and Grants," designated for the "Challenge Program," specific 91 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts 92 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts

93 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission 94 95 in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit 96 97 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the 98 99 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts 100 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 101 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of 102 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.

103 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 104 Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate 105 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to 106 exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), that may become 107 available to the Commission in accordance with the rules and 108 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 109 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 110 111 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 112 113 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 114 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 115 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 116 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 117
