HOUSE BILL NO. 1630

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE 2 EXPENSES AND PROVIDING CONTINGENT FUNDS FOR THE LEGISLATURE, THE 3 EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE, THE EXPENSES OF 4 THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE EVALUATION AND EXPENDITURE REVIEW, THE EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE 5 REAPPORTIONMENT COMMITTEE, PAYING THE MONTHLY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF 6 7 THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, PAYING THE STATE'S SHARE OF 8 VARIOUS ASSESSMENTS; EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AGRIBUSINESS COUNCIL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000. 9

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 14 salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Regular 15 Session of 1999 and providing contingent funds for the House of 16 Representatives and Senate for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 17 18 1999, and ending June 30, 2000, as follows: 19 For salaries, mileage, insurance, 20 matching funds and daily 21 expense allowance of members 22 of the House of Representatives..... \$3,727,380.00 For Contingent Fund for the 23 24 House of Representatives \$3,880,874.00

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 92 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 93 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 94 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 95 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 96 97 SECTION 7.
