HOUSE BILL NO. 1631

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 2 THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING 3 BENEFIT PAYMENTS TO RETIRANTS UNDER THE FORMER TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 8 of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of 9 10 paying supplementary annuities and additional annuities to retirants under the former Teachers' Retirement System, in 11 accordance with Section 25-11-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, to be 12 known as The Bea Barnard Memorial Fund, for the fiscal year 13 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 14 15\$ 57,312.00. 16 SECTION 2. The funds provided in Section 1 shall be known as 17 The Bea Barnard Memorial Fund, so named after Bea Barnard, a native of Lee County and the first publicly elected woman 18 Superintendent of Education in the State of Mississippi, serving 19 20 Sharkey County in that capacity for twenty-four (24) years. Mrs. Barnard died on May 31, 1990, having been a recipient of this fund 21 22 for many years. The minimum payment to retired teachers qualified to receive retirement benefits from the funds appropriated under 23 24 the provisions of Section 1 shall be Six Hundred Twenty-five 25 Dollars (\$625.00) per month, and the maximum benefit paid to such retirants shall be Seven Hundred Ninety-six Dollars (\$796.00) per 26 month. It is the intention of the Legislature that all retirants 27

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The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 33 SECTION 3. 34 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 35 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 36 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 37 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 38 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 1999. 40

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
