5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2)
7	of this section, the governing authorities of the City of
8	Southaven, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to
9	supplement the fire protection services of the Summershill Fire
10	District for territory removed from its fire district.
11	(2) No such agreement shall be entered into for an amount
12	larger than the projected property tax revenues imposed for
13	Summershill Fire District in the territory being released and no
14	such agreement shall be entered into until the removal of such
15	property tax from the individual landowners has taken place.
16	(3) (a) By agreement of the parties, the City of Southaven,
17	Mississippi, shall pay to Summershill Fire Protection District, as
18	compensation to the district for its loss of tax revenue and dues,
19	an annual amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred
20	Eighty-Seven Dollars and Ninety-three Cents (\$14,987.93), from any
21	available funds, during fiscal year 2000 and each fiscal year
22	thereafter for the next fourteen (14) years or until some party
23	retires or assumes the current debt of the Summershill Fire
24	Department.
25	(b) The City of Southaven, Mississippi, shall be fully
26	and wholly responsible for the fire protection within its

corporate limits located within the Summershill Fire Protection
