AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM AD VALOREM TAXATION BED AND BREAKFAST 1 2 INNS AND TOUR HOMES LISTED ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC 3 PLACES, DESIGNATED AS A MISSISSIPPI LANDMARK UNDER THE ANTIQUITIES 4 LAW OF MISSISSIPPI, OR LISTED AS A LANDMARK OR HISTORICAL PLACE BY 5 A LOCAL HISTORICAL DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Any bed and breakfast inn or tour home listed on 8 the National Register of Historic Places, designated as a Mississippi landmark under the Antiquities Law of Mississippi, or 9 listed as a landmark or historical place by a local historical 10 district, which property is open for tour by the general public at 11 least one hundred eighty (180) days per year or open for overnight 12 13 room rental by guests for at least one hundred eighty (180) days 14 per year, or both, shall be exempt from ad valorem taxation. For the purposes of this section, the term "bed and breakfast inn" 15 means an owner-operated establishment, located in a structure 16 formerly used as a single-family residence, where in consideration 17 of payment meals and overnight lodging are offered to guests, is 18 involved in the daily operations of the establishment. 19 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall affect or defeat any 20 21 claim, assessment, appeal, suit, right or cause of action for taxes due or accrued under the ad valorem tax laws before the date 2.2 on which this act becomes effective, whether such claims, 23 assessments, appeals, suits or actions have been begun before the 24 25 date on which this act becomes effective or are begun thereafter; and the provisions of the ad valorem tax laws are expressly 26 continued in full force, effect and operation for the purpose of 27

No. 1654 99\HR40\R1854 PAGE 1 the assessment, collection and enrollment of liens for any taxes due or accrued and the execution of any warrant under such laws before the date on which this act becomes effective, and for the imposition of any penalties, forfeitures or claims for failure to comply with such laws.

33 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after January 1, 2000.
