HOUSE BILL NO. 1696

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 972, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1994, 2 TO REVISE THE FEE IMPOSED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ADAMS 3 COUNTY ON THE GROSS REVENUE OF GAMING VESSELS DOCKED IN THE 4 COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 972, Local and Private Laws of 1994, is 7 amended as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Adams County may 8 require that every vessel, as defined in Section 27-109-1, 9 10 Mississippi Code of 1972, that docks in Adams County outside of the corporate limits of the City of Natchez, as such limits 11 existed on December 31, 1993, and on which legal gaming is 12 conducted, pay a fee of up to but not exceeding three and 13 two-tenths percent (3.2%) of the gross revenue of such vessel per 14 15 calendar month.

16 If the amount of fees required to be reported and paid 17 pursuant to this section is later determined to be greater or less 18 than the amount actually reported and paid by the vessel, the 19 Chairman of the State Tax Commission shall:

20 (a) Assess and collect the additional license fees21 determined to be due, with interest thereon until paid; or

(b) Advise the board of supervisors to refund any overpayment, with interest thereon, to the vessel. Interest must be computed, until paid, at the rate of one percent (1%) per month from the first day of the first month following either the due date of the additional fee or the date of overpayment.

27 The State Tax Commission shall calculate, collect and enforce

No. 1696 99\HR40\R1999 PAGE 1 28 the collection of such fee as provided for the calculation, 29 collection and enforcement of the license fee under Section 30 75-76-177, Mississippi Code of 1972. Not less than thirty (30) days before the effective date of the fee, the board of 31 supervisors shall furnish the State Tax Commission a certified 32 copy of the ordinance enacting the fee and establishing the 33 34 effective date, which shall be the first day of any month. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the avails of such fee are allocated 35 36 to Adams County, and twenty-five percent (25%) of the avails of 37 such fee are allocated to the City of Natchez. The State Tax Commission shall send the avails of such fee to the county and 38 39 municipality on or before the tenth day of each month following the month in which the fee was collected. Such monies shall be 40 deposited into the general fund of the county and the general fund 41 of the municipality. Such monies shall be expended by the county 42 43 as follows: (a) for the construction, operation and maintenance 44 of infrastructure relating to roads, rights-of-way, transportation, parking facilities, access, utilities, lighting, 45 traffic and safety devices, and related purposes; (b) for the 46 promotion of tourism, including, but not limited to, advertising 47 48 and construction of meeting and conference facilities; (c) for fire protection, security and law enforcement equipment and 49 50 personnel related to gaming; and (d) for any other use as may be determined by the board of supervisors. The board of supervisors 51 may allocate up to ten percent (10%) of such monies to fund budget 52 53 requests made by the Natchez-Adams School District. 54 Section 2. The fee authorized in Section 1 of this act is in

55 addition to the license fee authorized in Section 75-76-195, 56 Mississippi Code of 1972.

57 Section 3. Any vessel on which legal gaming is conducted 58 during the time that such vessel is docked in Adams County outside 59 the corporate limits of the City of Natchez is subject to zoning 60 regulations imposed by the board of supervisors to promote the

Commission may conduct inspections of such vessel to ensure
compliance with those regulations.

64 Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65 and after its passage.

66 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 67 and after its passage.

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
