HOUSE BILL NO. 1705
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JONES COUNTY,
2 MISSISSIPPI, THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF LAUREL,
3 MISSISSIPPI, THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF ELLISVILLE,
4 MISSISSIPPI, AND THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF SOSO,
5 MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE VETERANS MEMORIAL MUSEUM,
6 INCORPORATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Jones County,
9 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute funds,
10 from any available funds, up to a maximum amount of Ten Thousand
11 Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the Veterans Memorial
12 Museum, Incorporated.

13 SECTION 2. The governing authorities of the City of Laurel,
14 Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to contribute
15 funds, from any available funds, up to a maximum amount of ten
16 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the Veterans
17 Memorial Museum, Incorporated.

18 SECTION 3. The governing authorities of the City of
19 Ellisville, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to
20 contribute funds, from any available funds, up to a maximum amount
21 of ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the
22 Veterans Memorial Museum, Incorporated.

23 SECTION 4. The governing authorities of the Town of Soso,
24 Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to contribute
25 funds, from any available funds, up to a maximum amount of ten
26 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the Veterans
27 Memorial Museum, Incorporated.

28 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from

29 and after its passage and shall be repealed from and after July 1,
30 2004.
