HOUSE BILL NO. 1710
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SMITH COUNTY,
2 MISSISSIPPI, AND THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF
3 TAYLORSVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE VETERANS
4 MEMORIAL MUSEUM, INCORPORATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Smith County,
7 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute funds,
8 from any available funds, up to a maximum amount of Ten Thousand
9 Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the Veterans Memorial
10 Museum, Incorporated.

11 SECTION 2. The governing authorities of the Town of
12 Taylorsville, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to
13 contribute funds, from any available funds, up to a maximum amount
14 of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the
15 Veterans Memorial Museum, Incorporated.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after its passage and shall be repealed from and after July 1,
18 2004.
