HOUSE BILL NO. 1710 (As Passed the House)

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SMITH COUNTY,
- 2 MISSISSIPPI, AND THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF
- 3 TAYLORSVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE VETERANS
- 4 MEMORIAL MUSEUM, INCORPORATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Smith County,
- 7 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute funds,
- 8 from any available funds, up to a maximum amount of Ten Thousand
- 9 Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the Veterans Memorial
- 10 Museum, Incorporated.
- 11 SECTION 2. The governing authorities of the Town of
- 12 Taylorsville, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized to
- 13 contribute funds, from any available funds, up to a maximum amount
- 14 of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per calendar year, to the
- 15 Veterans Memorial Museum, Incorporated.
- 16 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage and shall be repealed from and after July 1,
- 18 2004.
