HOUSE BILL NO. 1727
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL
2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AD VALOREM TAXES ON PROPERTY IN THE
3 COUNTY FOR WHICH AN AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION IS INITIALLY GRANTED
4 ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT UNDER SECTION
5 27-31-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972; TO PROVIDE THAT THE AVAILS OF
6 SUCH AD VALOREM TAX LEVY SHALL BE USED FOR POLICE PROTECTION AND
7 FIRE PROTECTION PURPOSES IN THE COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
10 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to levy an ad
11 valorem tax in an amount not to exceed two (2) mills on all
12 taxable property in the county for which an ad valorem tax
13 exemption is initially granted on or after the effective date of
14 this act under Section 27-31-101, Mississippi Code of 1972. The
15 avails of the ad valorem tax levy shall be deposited into the
16 general fund of the county and shall be expended for police
17 protection purposes in the county.

18 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
19 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to levy an ad
20 valorem tax in an amount not to exceed two (2) mills on all
21 taxable property in the county for which an ad valorem tax
22 exemption is initially granted on or after the effective date of
23 this act under Section 27-31-101, Mississippi Code of 1972. The
24 avails of the ad valorem tax levy shall be deposited into the
25 general fund of the county and shall be expended for fire
26 protection purposes in the county.

27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
28 and after its passage.
