- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to James Charles McGrew of Adams County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction of theft in Claiborne County, Mississippi, in 1973, and
- 8 who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon him
- 9 for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed
- 10 that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 11 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after its passage.
