HOUSE BILL NO. 1728 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JAMES CHARLES 2 MCGREW OF ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and completely restored to James Charles McGrew of Adams County, 5 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his 6 7 conviction of theft in Claiborne County, Mississippi, in 1973, and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon him 8 9 for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed 10 that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner. 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 12

13 and after its passage.
