HOUSE BILL NO. 1729
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KENNETH BRIDGES OF
2 RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Kenneth Bridges of Rankin County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of embezzlement in Rankin County, Mississippi, in 1989,
8 and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon
9 him for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably
10 informed that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and
11 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
