HOUSE BILL NO. 1729 (As Passed the House)

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KENNETH BRIDGES OF RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Kenneth Bridges of Rankin County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction of embezzlement in Rankin County, Mississippi, in 1989,
- 8 and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon
- 9 him for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably
- 10 informed that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and
- 11 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after its passage.
