- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PASCAGOULA TO ESTABLISH,
- 2 PROMOTE AND DEVELOP TOURISM AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of
- 7 Pascagoula, in their discretion, may establish, promote and
- 8 develop tourism and economic development within the municipality.
- 9 SECTION 2. In order to effectuate the purposes of this act,
- 10 the governing authorities of the City of Pascagoula may:
- 11 (a) Acquire, own, lease, furnish, equip, staff and
- 12 operate any facilities and equipment necessary and useful in the
- 13 promotion of tourism and economic development;
- 14 (b) Receive funds from any source;
- 15 (c) Expend funds from the general fund and any other
- 16 lawful source;
- 17 (d) Purchase, sell, lease and dispose of all real and
- 18 personal property necessary and useful in exercising the authority
- 19 granted in this act;
- 20 (e) Employ such personnel as is necessary and
- 21 convenient to effectuate the purposes of this act; and
- 22 (f) Have and exercise all other powers necessary or
- 23 convenient to effectuate the purposes of this act.
- 24 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after its passage.
