HOUSE BILL NO. 1733
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ERIC CHARLES
2 NICHOLS OF HANCOCK COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Eric Charles Nichols of Hancock County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of false pretense, burglary and uttering forgery, in
8 Hancock and Harrison Counties, Mississippi, in 1980, and his
9 conviction of transfer of a controlled substance in Hancock
10 County, Mississippi, in 1993, and who has completed the penalty
11 and any conditions imposed upon him for such conviction. The
12 Legislature has been reliably informed that he is now conducting
13 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
14 lawful manner.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
16 and after its passage.
