## HOUSE BILL NO. 1737 (As Passed the House)

(1) The Board of Supervisors of Tallahatchie 10 County, Mississippi, is authorized to create the Tallahatchie County Children's Services Commission (commission). The 11 commission shall consist of the following four (4) members: the 12 Superintendent of the East Tallahatchie Consolidated School 13 14 District, or his designee; the Superintendent of the West 15 Tallahatchie Consolidated School District, or his designee; the Youth Court Referee of Tallahatchie County, or his designee; and 16 the Attendance Counselor for Tallahatchie County, or his designee. 17 (2) The commission is authorized to develop an annual plan 18 for Tallahatchie County in regard to preventing delinquency of the 19 youth of Tallahatchie County and promoting job training and skills 20 and good citizenship training for the youth of Tallahatchie 21 22 County.
