HOUSE BILL NO. 1744  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DESOTO COUNTY  
2 TO DEPOSIT VENDING MACHINE PROCEEDS INTO A SPECIAL FUND TO BE USED  
3 FOR BENEVOLENT PURPOSES FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES; AND FOR RELATED  
4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County,  
7 Mississippi, in its discretion, by resolution duly adopted and  
8 entered on its minutes, may create a special fund in the county  
9 treasury to be known as the "Vending Machine Special Fund," into  
10 which may be deposited a portion of the proceeds, not to exceed  
11 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per year, due to the county from  
12 the vending machines located at county facilities and on property  
13 owned by the county. Money deposited into the Vending Machine  
14 Special Fund shall be used for the benevolent purpose of  
15 commemorating special occasions for county employees. The board  
16 of supervisors shall appoint a committee, to be comprised of three  
17 (3) employees of the county, to administer the fund, and  
18 expenditures from the fund shall be upon the recommendation of the  
19 committee. The board of supervisors shall include guidelines for  
20 the expenditure of monies in the Vending Machine Special Fund in  
21 the resolution creating the fund.

22 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after July 1,  
23 2004.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
25 and after its passage.
